## Temporary amendment to the visa-issuing process at the external border (Schiphol) for seafarers signing on due to consular departments being closed down because of the COVID-19 measures.

The Royal Netherlands Marechaussee is facilitating the temporary issuing of visas to seafarers at Amsterdam Airport Schiphol requiring a visa.

This option is only offered to seafarers who (1) are unable to obtain a visa in their country of origin due to the closure, limited capacity or technical restrictions of the Dutch embassies abroad (as a result of COVID-19), (2) are on their way to

(a) ships belonging to a Dutch ship-owning company or (b) ships flying the Dutch flag and of (c) ships belonging to a Foreign ship-owning company (3) are anchored in a Dutch harbour.

In addition to the three criteria above, the following procedure applies to the processing of a request for issuing a visa at the border through this temporary process:

- 1. A timeslot needs to be allocated for requesting a visa at the border. To request this timeslot, click <a href="here">here</a>. If a timeslot is available and the applicant meets the three criteria mentioned above, they will receive confirmation (OK to apply) of the timeslot having been allocated.
- 2. No later than 72 hours before the seafarer arrives in the Netherlands, the 'STVZ COVID-19' form and the documents below will be sent to the Royal Dutch Marechaussee at Schiphol (VAP.GB@mindef.nl):
  - a. copy of a valid national passport and/orseaman's book;
  - b. fully completed sponsor declaration;
  - c. flight details from country of origin to Dutch airport (Schiphol);
  - d. name of Dutch embassy or consular representative that would usually process the application;
  - e. any other relevant documents that could increase the chances of the form being approved.
- 3. The Royal Dutch Marechaussee will inform the applicant that their application is being processed (OK to board).

Applications without an allocated timeslot as mentioned at Step 1 (OK to apply) will not be processed by the Royal Netherlands Marechaussee.
